During the hearings in this matter, which were held in Harrisburg on August 25, and 26, 2003, witnesses for Verizon, AT&T, MCI, Qwest, OTS, OCA and OSBA were cross-examined. Written testimony and exhibits were entered into the record. On the record data requests were made and the procedural schedule was revised.
