AP Gas & Electric (PA), LLC – Letter of Credit Return

To Secretary Chiavetta,

On or about August 2010, AP Gas & Electric (PA), LLC submitted its Electric Generation Service (“EGS”) application with your office and the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. Contained within the EGS application packet, AP Gas & Electric (PA), LLC submitted an original-executed letter of credit as financial collateral, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code. The original letter of credit was issued by Prosperity Bank and in the amount of \$250,000. [See attached a copy of the letter of credit] Since then, as required by the Public Utility Commission, AP Gas & Electric (PA), LLC has amended and/or supplanted its financial collateral with surety bonds and in an amount much greater than the original letter of credit.

As such, since the letter of credit is no longer effective, we are requesting a return of the original-executed letter of credit. Please find enclosed a return Fedex envelope to return the original-executed letter of credit.
