**MOTION OF PECO ENERGY COMPANY TO
WITHDRAW FORMAL COMPLAINT**

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), hereby motions to withdraw the company's formal complaint, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a) and states the following:

1. On May 13, 2014, PECO Energy filed a formal complaint, appealing Bureau of Consumer Services ("BCS") case number 003185757, wherein the BCS issued Faith Price a payment agreement.
2. An In-Person hearing is scheduled to take place Monday, October 27, 2014, before Administrative Law Judge Angela T. Jones.
3. PECO Energy respectfully requests to withdraw the company's formal complaint, appealing the BCS Decision.
4. 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a) states:

Except as provided in subsection (b), a party desiring to withdraw a pleading in a contested proceeding may file a petition for leave to withdraw the appropriate document with the Commission and serve it upon the other parties. The petition must set forth the reasons for the withdrawal. A party may object to the petition within 20 days of service. After considering the petition, an objection thereto and the public interest, the presiding officer or the Commission will determine whether the withdrawal will be permitted.
5. "Pleading" is defined as "an application, complaint, petition, answer, motion, protest, reply, or other similar document filed in a proceeding." 52 Pa. Code § 1.8(a).

6. PECO Energy respectfully requests to withdraw the formal complaint.
7. The BCS payment agreement at issue has defaulted; therefore, the issue is moot.
8. A hearing in this matter is not required because the issue is no longer contested.
9. Not holding a hearing for this matter is in the public interest because it saves the Commission time and resources.

10. Accordingly, PECO Energy respectfully requests that this Honorable Commission grant PECO Energy's Motion to Withdraw the formal complaint at docket number C-2014-2428686 and cancel the hearing scheduled to take place on October 27, 2014.

WHEREFORE, PECO Energy respectfully requests that this Honorable Commission grant PECO Energy's Motion to Withdraw Formal Complaint.
