

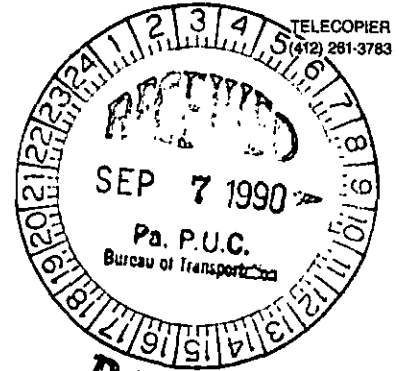

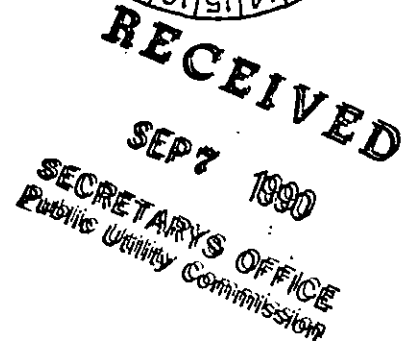

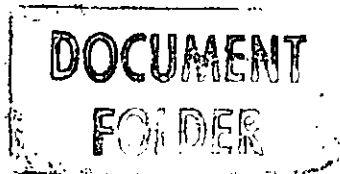

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 14 day of SEP 1990, between CENTRAL CONTROL DELIVERY, INC. a corporation with a business address of 1424 East 25th Street, Cleveland, OH 44114-2123, and CRANE VALVE COMPANY (SHIPPER) with a business address of 1120 Ohioview Avenue, Ambridge, PA 15003.



I. PREMISES

A. CARRIER holds contract carrier authority from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") at Docket No. A-108543 which authorizes it to perform certain contract carrier service by motor vehicle for SHIPPER.

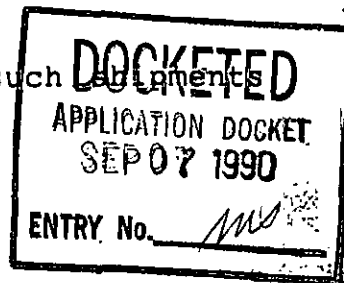
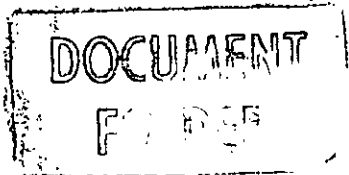
B. CARRIER and SHIPPER wish to comply with the rules and regulations of the PUC and have therefore entered into this Agreement.

II. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. SHIPPER will tender to CARRIER a minimum of 100,000 pounds of freight per year for transportation within the scope of CARRIER's operating authority at Docket No. A-108453. The scope of CARRIER's operating rights is set forth in Appendix "A".

2. CARRIER will charge SHIPPER and SHIPPER will pay to CARRIER for any transportation performed under this Agreement in accordance with the conditions, rates and charges specified in CARRIER's schedule of rates which are set forth in Appendix "B" hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

3. CARRIER will accept for transportation such shipments



as SHIPPER shall, pursuant to the terms of this Agreement and within the capabilities and legal rights of the CARRIER, call upon CARRIER to transport.

4. This Agreement can be cancelled by either party upon thirty (30) days advance written notice to the other party.

5. This Agreement shall become effective from the date of execution and shall remain in effect from year to year subject to the provisions of Paragraph 4 herein concerning the thirty (30) day advance notice of cancellation.

6. This Agreement shall be binding upon the successors, assigns, administrators and executors of the parties hereto.

7. The parties hereby stipulate and agree that this Agreement will not result in an effect on the quality of the human environment.

8. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and it cancels or replaces any other agreement or arrangements heretofore in existence.
