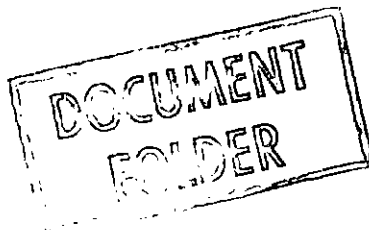

PETITION TO REINSTATE OPERATING RIGHTS

AND NOW, comes Central Control Delivery, Inc. ("CCD" or "Respondent"), by and through its counsel, and files this Petition to Reinstate Operating Rights and in support thereof states as follows:

1. Respondent was granted a contract carrier permit at Docket No. A-00108543 on July 30, 1990.

2. Respondent conducted operations pursuant to this grant of authority from a satellite terminal in the Pittsburgh area, however, due to a lack of business, Respondent was forced to close this terminal in January, 1991.

3. Respondent did not conduct any intrastate operations or receive any revenues from intrastate operations during 1991.

4. Respondent did not file its 1991 Annual Report because it did not have any operating revenues in 1991, and Respondent was not aware that it was still required to file an Annual Report and indicate that it had no revenues.

5. On July 8, 1992, the Commission entered an Order to Show Cause for failure of Respondent to file its 1991 Annual Report. Upon receipt of the Complaint, Respondent sent a letter either to the Commission or the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue, advising that it did not have any revenues from Pennsylvania operations in 1991. Respondent was under the mistaken impression that this would satisfy its reporting requirements.

6. On September 8, 1992, the Commission entered an Order canceling its contract carrier permit for failure to comply with the Commission's regulations.

7. Respondent consulted with transportation counsel in Pennsylvania and, based upon the advice of counsel, Respondent has prepared and filed with the Commission its 1991 Annual Report. A copy of the Annual Report is attached hereto as Exhibit "A". Although Exhibit "A" is an unsigned copy, the original of the Annual Report was signed and notarized.

8. Respondent has also filed its 1991 Assessment Report with the Commission, and a copy of the Assessment Report is attached as Exhibit "B". Although Exhibit "B" is an unsigned copy, the original of the 1991 Assessment Report was signed and notarized.


9. Respondent submits that it has taken prompt action to correct the unintentional oversight in not complying with the Commission's regulations in filing the Annual Report and Assessment Report for 1991.

10. Respondent also submits that it has a good record of complying with the Commission's regulations and that it has not been cited for any other safety or other violations.

WHEREFORE, Respondent, Central Control Delivery, Inc., requests that the Commission exercise its discretion and rescind its Order canceling its contract carrier permit and grant this Petition to reinstate its operating rights.

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


