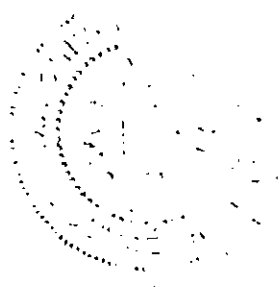

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between Sloane Moving and Storage Co. Inc., hereinafter referred to as Transferee, and Patrick J. Stanton, t/d/b/a Sloane Moving and Storage Company, hereinafter referred to as Transferor, this 4<sup>th</sup> day of *January*, 1987.

WHEREAS, Transferor is a certificated common carrier by motor vehicle of property authorized by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PA PUC) to perform transportation for hire; and

WHEREAS, Transferee is a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania organized and created by Transferor for the purpose of receiving the authority and other property of Transferor; and

WHEREAS, Transferor desires to sell and transfer, and Transferee desires to purchase and receive Transferor's PA PUC authority and other property;

WHEREFORE, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements, hereby agree as follows:

1. Transferor agrees to sell and transfer and Transferee agrees to purchase and receive the PA PUC authority of Transferor issued at Docket A-100631, F.2 and A-100631, F.2, Am-A. A copy of authorities proposed to be transferred to Transferee herein are attached hereto as Appendix I. A list of other tangible property proposed to be transferred is attached to the application as Schedule A and B and made a part hereof. The Giving Effect or pro-forma balance sheet attached shows other assets to be transferred and liabilities to be assumed and is attached hereto as Schedule C.

2. The total consideration moving from Transferee to Transferor is One Dollar (\$1.00) and shall be paid as follows:



The consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) shall be paid in cash after Commission approval of the transaction and at the time of consummation.

3. After approval by the PA PUC of an application for transfer to be filed before it, and at the time of consummation, hereinafter defined, but prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience to Transferee by the Commission, Transferee shall issue to Transferor and his wife 1000 shares of the common capital stock (par value \$ .01 each share) of the corporation in consideration of a cash payment of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

4. Approval as used in this Agreement shall mean consent of the PA PUC of the application filed before such regulatory agency for transfer of the herein subject property from Transferor to Transferee, without any deletions of and without any restrictions in commodity or territory in the authority as it now exists.

5. Consummation as used in this Agreement shall mean that date, after approval of the PA PUC as hereinbefore defined, that all monies or stock due are paid over or issued to the Transferor and entries are made upon the books of the Transferee, and the Transferor executes any tariff adoption notice, if necessary.

6. Consummation shall take place within twenty (20) days after receipt by Raymond A. Thistle, Jr., counsel for Transferee and Transferor of approval by the

PA PUC of the transfer and receipt by him of the Commission's tariff compliance instructions. The place of consummation shall be at said counsel's office, 206B Benson East, 100 Old York Road, Jenkintown, PA 19046, by mail or at any place mutually agreed upon by the parties.

7. Transferee agrees that it will bear the financial obligation of prompt preparation of the formal agreement between the parties; the prompt preparation, filing and prosecution of the application before the PA PUC and the consummation of the transaction.

3. Transferor agrees that it will fully cooperate in furnishing necessary information for the preparation of the Agreement and application and will attend and furnish information pertaining to it at any hearing required and execute all necessary documents to fulfil the intent of this Agreement, all at its own expense.


9. In order to legitimately avoid duplication of Pennsylvania State license and transfer fees for the motor vehicles which, inter alia, are subject to this transfer agreement, it is understood and agreed between Transferor and Transferee that the titles to such motor vehicles will not be transferred to Transferee until the next regular licensing and renewal licensing period in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. After approval by the PA PUC of the transaction and until such next regular licensing period, such motor vehicle equipment will be leased by Transferor to Transferee. In consideration of said lease, Transferee will be responsible for the costs of all insurance, gas, oil, repairs, depreciation, maintenance, fines for violations, operations, and any and all expenses involving such motor vehicle equipment.

10. All parties will perform their respective obligations within a reasonable time to effectuate the intent of this Agreement.

11. Having been agreed to and made in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, this Agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws thereof.

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application docketed February 17, 1978, Patrick J. Stanton,  
t/a Sloane Moving and Storage Company seeks approval of the transfer to  
applicant of all the right granted to Stephen P. Sloane under the cer-  
tificate issued at A. 60492, F. 2.

Application was published on March 11, 1978 in the Pennsylvania  
Bulletin. No protests were filed and no hearing held.

Applicant is not yet in compliance with the Fictitious Names  
Act with the Pennsylvania Department of State.

Applicant proposes to purchase all of the transferor's motor  
carrier trucking rights at A. 60492, F. 2, 2 vehicles being included,  
for a total consideration of \$6,300.

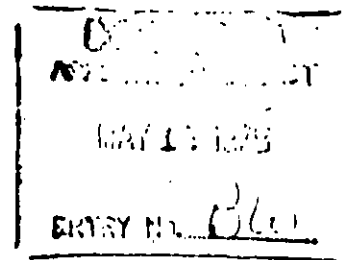
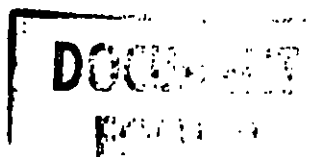
This consideration will be paid as follows: \$600 has been  
placed in escrow with C. B. Neilson. The balance of \$5,700 to be paid  
upon Commission's approval of the instant application.

Applicant shows assets of \$17,250, subject to no liabilities.

Transferor's gross intrastate carrier revenues as per annual  
and assessment reports were:

1975 - \$24,359, 1976 - \$26,715 and 1977 - \$32,768.

All due assessments have been paid.



FINDINGS

Applicant appears to be financially fit to operate as a common carrier. Transferor is presently operating, has insurance in effect and tariff on file. It appears the certificate is in good standing and therefore subject to being transferred.

We find the applicant to be fit to hold a certificate of public convenience and that approval of the application is necessary and proper for the continuation of service to the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application for approval of the transfer of right held by Stephen P. Sloane at A. 60492, F. 2 be approved and that a certificate be issued to the applicant granting the following right:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, household furniture in use between points in the city and county of Philadelphia, east of Broad Street and north of Erie Avenue and from points in the said area, to points in the counties of Philadelphia, Montgomery, Delaware, and Bucks, and vice versa;

subject to the following conditions:

1. That the approval hereby given is not to be understood as committing the Commission, in any proceedings that may be brought before it for any purpose, to fix a valuation on the property and right to be acquired by applicant from the present certificate holder equal to the consideration to be paid therefor, or equal to any value that may be placed thereon by applicant, or to approve or prescribe rates sufficient to yield a return thereon.
2. That the accounts of the transferee shall reflect the same book values as the records of the transferor at the effective date of the transfer, any previously recorded appreciation having been deleted therefrom; provided that the applicant shall not record in his utility accounts any amounts representing the right herein granted in excess of the actual cost of such right to the original holder thereof.
3. That the certificate holder shall comply with all of the provisions of the Public Utility Law as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and Pa. Code: Title 52, Chapter 31, as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and any other rules and regulations as may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission. Failure to comply shall be sufficient cause to suspend, revoke or rescind the right and privileges conferred by the certificate.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it shall have complied with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law and the rules and regulations of this Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of evidence of insurance and a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That issuance of the certificate be withheld pending submission of proof of compliance with the provisions of the Fictitious Names Act.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before thirty days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That upon compliance with this order the right granted the transferor Stephen P. Sloane at A. 60492, F. 2 be canceled and the record be marked closed.

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O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed August 1, 1985. Notice of the application was filed in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of August 17, 1985. No protests were filed and this record is certified to the Commission without oral hearing.

Applicant shows assets of \$62,415, subject to liabilities of \$10,300, and a capital account of \$52,115.

The applicant proposes to purchase all of the transferor's motor carrier trucking rights at A-00095529 for a total consideration of \$16,500 that will be paid \$5,000 upon execution of the sales agreement and remaining sum of \$11,500 upon the PUC approval of the instant order.

Transferor shows gross revenue for 1983 of \$33,325 and 1984 of \$80,692. All of the transferor's due assessments have been paid and all reports have been filed.

We find that:

1. Applicant is fit to hold a certificate of public convenience.
2. There is a continuing necessity for the rights herein involved.
3. Approval of the instant application is necessary for the continuation of services to the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application for the transfer of rights held by American Freight Corp. at A-00095529 be and is hereby approved and that an order be issued to the applicant granting the following rights:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, property (excluding household goods in use and excluding perishable fruits and produce) between points in the city and county of Philadelphia.



To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods, aircraft and personal property in use, including furniture, furnishings, stock and fixtures, equipment and works of art of dwelling houses, stores, institutions and libraries, between points in the counties of Philadelphia, Delaware, Chester, Montgomery and Bucks, included within a line which connects the boundaries of Chester, West Chester, Norristown, Paoli, Doylestown and Morrisville, but not including said places;

To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods, aircraft and other personal property in use, including furniture, furnishings, stock and fixtures, equipment and works of art of dwelling houses, stores, institutions and libraries, from points in the counties of Philadelphia, Delaware, Chester, Montgomery and Bucks, included within a line which connects the boundaries of Chester, West Chester, Norristown, Paoli, Doylestown and Morrisville, but not including said places, to points in Pennsylvania within an airline distance of one hundred fifty (150) statute miles of the Philadelphia City Hall.

1. That the approval hereby given is not to be understood as committing the Commission, in any proceedings that may be brought before it for any purpose, to fix a valuation on the rights to be acquired by applicant from the present certificate holder equal to the consideration to be paid therefor, or equal to any value that may be placed thereon by applicant, or to approve or prescribe rates sufficient to yield a return thereon.
2. That applicant shall not record in its utility accounts any amount representing the rights herein granted in excess of the actual cost of such rights to the original holder thereof.
3. That the \$16,500 consideration paid by applicant for the rights and going concern value of the business be capitalized by applicant in Account 1550 - Other Intangible Property or in the alternative be charged off against applicant's ownership equity less any amount recorded under condition 2 above; provided the latter is sufficient in amount to absorb said charge off.

4. That the certificate holder shall comply with all of the provisions of the Public Utility Law as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and Pa. Code Title 52, Chapter 29, as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and any other rules and regulations as may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission. Failure to comply shall be sufficient cause to suspend, revoke or rescind the rights and privileges conferred by the certificate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That approval of the authority be withheld pending receipt of the 1985 Annual Report of the transferor.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it shall have complied with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code and the rules and regulations of this Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of evidence of insurance and a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein, to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the carrier, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That upon compliance with this order the rights granted the transferor, American Freight Corp. at A-00095529 be cancelled and the record be marked closed.
