This is to advise that this office represents Southland Container, Inc. of Jessup, Maryland. My client has instituted litigation in the Court of Common Pleas of Philadelphia as of No. 870, May Term, 1992 to collect a debt of \$11,465.93 owed to my client by D. Cristinzio, Inc.

We understand that D. Cristinzio, Inc. is about to transfer its PUC authority to Ace Moving and Storage Co., which we believe is an attempt to render itself insolvent and to fraudulently defeat the claims of its creditors.

This is to advise that we believe the above transfer is being consummated by D. Cristinzio, Inc. as a fraudulent conveyance to defeat the rights of my client and, as such, we would like to place the parties on notice that we intend to attach any proceeds from the sale of this license.
