TRANSFER AGREEMENT

This Transfer Agreement made this 23rd day of August, 1988, by and between DAVID CARUSO and JOSEPH CARUSO, Copartners, now of Larksville, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as "Transferors," and ACE MOVING & STORAGE CORPORATION, a Pennsylvania corporation of Larksville, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as "Transferee."

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, Transferors have previously transferred to Transferee other aspects of their business and now desires to transfer their partnership interest in the operating authority issued by this Commission to said corporation and Transferee is desirous of acquiring same.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto do mutually promise, covenant and agree as follows:

I. Transferors agree:

A. To transfer to Transferee the Certificate docketed at A.104894 for a consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar, payable in cash, upon approval of the transfer by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

B. To continue to operate said authority until the transfer has been approved.

II. Transferee agrees:

A. To acquire the authority listed in Paragraph I.A. hereof for the consideration therein specified payable in the manner set forth above.

III. Both parties agree:

A. It is their intention to be legally bound by this Agreement which shall also be binding upon and enure to the benefit of their respective successors and assigns.

B. They have executed this Agreement in due legal form by full legal authority so to do.



O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application docketed August 22, 1983, David Caruso and Joseph Caruso, Copartners, seeks approval of the transfer to it of part of the rights granted to William Caruso, t/a Ace Moving Company, under the certificate issued at A-00074801, F. 3; transferor is retaining part of his operating rights at F. 3.

We find the applicant to be fit to hold a certificate of public convenience and that approval of the application is necessary and proper for the continuation of service to the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application for the transfer of part of the rights held by William Caruso, t/a Ace Moving Company, at A-00074801, F. 3 be approved and that a certificate be issued to the applicant granting the following rights:

1. To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods, in use, between points in the city of Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, and within three (3) miles of the limits of the said city.
2. To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods, in use, from points in the city of Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, and within three (3) miles of the limits of the said city to other points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa;

with rights Nos. 1 and 2 above subject to the following condition:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport household goods, in use, from, to or between points in the city of Nanticoke, Luzerne County, and within five (5) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of said city. ;

3. To transport, as a Class D carrier, household goods and office furniture, in use, between points in the city of Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, and within ten (10) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of said city, provided no haul shall exceed a distance of ten (10) miles from point of origin to point of destination;

with right No. 3 above subject to the following conditions:

- a. That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport household goods, in use, from, to or between points in the city of Nanticoke, Luzerne County, and within five (5) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of said city.
- b. That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport household goods, in use, from, to or between points in the city of Scranton, Lackawanna County, and within three (3) miles of the limits of said city;

with all of the above rights further subject to the following general conditions:

1. That the approval hereby given is not to be understood as committing the Commission, in any proceedings that may be brought before it for any purpose, to fix a valuation on the rights to be acquired by applicant from the present certificate holder equal to the consideration to be paid therefor, or equal to any value that may be placed thereon by applicant, or to approve or prescribe rates sufficient to yield a return thereon.
2. That applicant shall not record in its utility accounts any amount representing the rights herein granted, in excess of the actual cost of such rights to the original holder thereof.

3. That the \$1 consideration paid by applicant for the rights and going concern value of the business be capitalized by applicant in Account 1550 - Other Intangible Property or in the alternative be charged off against applicant's ownership equity less any amount recorded under condition 2 above; provided the latter is sufficient in amount to absorb said charge off.
4. That the operating authority granted herein or subsequently granted to the applicant to the extent that it is duplicative shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.
5. That the certificate holder shall comply with all of the provisions of the Public Utility Law as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and Pa. Code Title 52, Chapter 31, as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and any other rules and regulations as may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission. Failure to comply shall be sufficient cause to suspend, revoke or rescind the rights and privileges conferred by the certificate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it has complied with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Law and the rules and regulations of this Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of evidence of insurance and a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That upon compliance with this order, the rights granted the transferor, William Caruso, t/a Ace Moving Company, at A-00074801, F. 3 be modified so as to eliminate the authority transferred herein; and that the tariff as applicable to the right being retained be modified accordingly.
