MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. A telephonic hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Monday, November 17, 2014 at 1:00 p.m.
2. The Complainant's formal complaint alleges voltage issues at her residence located at 2144 Aquetong Road, New Hope, PA.
3. During a pre-hearing resolution conference call that took place on October 30, 2014, the Complainant indicated that she has continuing issues with her voltage and based on PECO's analysis it may be related to the Complainant's solar power system.
4. To determine the root cause of the Complainant's voltage issues, PECO Energy needs to perform testing at the Complainant's residence to monitor voltage with her solar power system connected and with the system disconnected.
5. The voltage test needs to be performed over a three week period to obtain accurate readings.
6. PECO Energy will offer the voltage testing data and report at the time of the hearing.

7. Accordingly, PECO Energy and the Complainant jointly request a continuance of the hearing for three weeks to have the voltage testing performed.

8. In the event this matter proceeds to hearing, PECO Energy requests that the hearing be scheduled at 10:00 a.m. as opposed to 1:00 p.m. because of the number of witnesses that will need to testify. Holding the hearing in the morning will prevent the need for a further hearing.
