1. An in person hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Tuesday, November 4, 2014 at 9:30 a.m.
2. The Complainant's formal complaint alleges a billing dispute and high bills.
3. During a pre-hearing resolution discussion today, the Complainant indicated that he had some issues with his newly installed AMI meter.
