ORDER GRANTING PARTIES' REQUEST TO REVISE
THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In telephone calls and electronic mail messages dated May 19, 2004, the parties have requested that I revise and bifurcate the procedural schedule in light of recent developments. The parties have requested that the GCR filing and CRRC petition be placed on two separate tracks as a result of the impending proposed settlement of the GCR (including GCR, USC and Restructuring surcharges), and the parties desire to extend the procedural schedule by three (3) weeks in regard to the CRRC petition so that they can engage in settlement discussions. The parties' request is granted.

Therefore, the following two schedules are established.

GCR Procedural Schedule

May 26, 2004	GCR settlement document in-hand to presiding officer
June 9, 2004	written comments from any non-signatory parties due
September 1, 2004	effective date

OCA is to serve all parties with a copy of the GCR settlement document and inform them of the due date for any written comments. OCA must also inform the parties that any written comments must be filed with the Commission, and sent to the presiding officer and other parties.


CRRC Schedule

June 14, 2004	Main briefs due in-hand
June 22, 2004	Reply briefs due in-hand to presiding officer
September 22, 2004	effective date

PGW, as it has agreed to do, must file tariff pages voluntarily extending the effective date of the proposed CRRC to September 22, 2004.

In the event a settlement of the CRRC is reached, I will establish a schedule to allow any non-signatory parties an opportunity to be heard either orally or in writing.
