
NOTICE TO PLEAD

PECO ENERGY’S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. An in person further hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place Monday, November 20, 2014 at 2:00 p.m.
2. PECO Energy requests a continuance of this matter.
3. In the Complainant’s formal complaints she raises an issue with high monthly bills, disputes her \$10,000 bill, and requests “accurate meter readings.”
4. To defend the Complainant’s allegations, PECO Energy will present the testimony of Senior Engineer, Dennis Fitti, to testify to meter test results.
5. Additionally, prior to the hearing, PECO Energy would like to conduct a high bill field investigation at the Complainant’s residence and present the report and a high bill field witness at the hearing.
6. Mr. Fitti is not available for the November 20th afternoon hearing.
7. Further, because PECO will be presenting at least three witnesses at the time of the hearing, the company requests a morning hearing. Having the hearing conducted in the morning will prevent the necessity of a further hearing.

8. Accordingly, PECO Energy respectfully requests a continuance of this matter to another date with a morning hearing.

9. The Prehearing Order in this matter states that requests for a continuance are only granted “in rare situations where good cause exists.” (Prehearing Order, citing 52 Pa. Code § 1.15).

10. PECO Energy avers that “good cause” exists to continue the scheduled hearing to another date because one of PECO Energy’s witnesses is unavailable.

11. PECO Energy therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
