ORDER GRANTING PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS'
MOTION FOR WAIVER OF PAGE LIMIT

During the prehearing conference held in this proceeding on June 10, 2004, it was established that briefs would be limited to 60 pages. (Tr. 577). That requirement was memorialized in my prehearing order dated June 11, 2004.

On July 12, 2004, Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW) filed a "Motion for Waiver of Page Limit." In its Motion, PGW requests that the length of main briefs be extended to no more than 120 pages and that the length of reply briefs be extended to no more than 80 pages. PGW argues that it may need the additional pages due to the scope of the Investigation and the number of issues to be addressed. PGW also notes that it contacted the other parties regarding this matter and that it has heard from the following parties, none of whom oppose its Motion: Office of Trial Staff, Office of Consumer Advocate, PECO Energy Company and Philadelphia Industrial and Commercial Gas Users Group.

PGW has shown good cause for increasing the page limit for briefs. will therefore grant PGW's Motion.


