ORDER ADJUSTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

By Order entered June 28, 2004, the Commission directed that the procedural schedule be adjusted to allow additional time for discovery and briefing. At the hearing held on July 6, 2004, I adjusted the procedural schedule pursuant to the Commission's Order. The procedural schedule was adjusted as follows:

1. Discovery

Discovery may continue. However, any document marked as an exhibit that a party wants admitted into evidence after the close of evidentiary hearings (which was yesterday) must be moved into evidence upon written stipulation of the parties or upon written motion of a party, subject to written objection. A copy of the exhibit must be attached to the written stipulation or written motion. Any written stipulation or written motion for the admission of an exhibit into evidence must be in my hands and the hands of the other parties no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 12, 2004. Any objections to a written motion for the admission of an exhibit into evidence must be in my hands within 3 days of the date of submission of the written motion. For example, if a written motion for the admission of an exhibit into evidence is submitted on July 12, 2004, then any objections are due no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 15, 2004. A party must in its brief clearly identify any exhibit referenced in its brief that has not been admitted into evidence. The party must also provide in its brief the submission date of its pending written motion or written stipulation, and the submission date of any written objection.


