1. The respondent received a document titled "Form of Certificate of Service", with the documentation, EXCEPTIONS FILED WITH RESPECT TO INTERLOCUTORY DECISIONS, entered at the end of the same page. The document was clearly not titled by this ending statement. The respondent also received an attached letter, with the explanation that the filing was late as a result of the Initial Decision being received by the complainant, October 16, 2014 via USPS. The document was not purported but actually stated its intention.
2. The respondent documents that the Initial Decision was not only dated September 9, 2014, but that respondent also received the document on the same date, September 9, 2014. The respondent again does not offer that a letter did accompany complainant's response, documenting that the Initial Decision was not received by complainant until October 16, 2014 via USPS, nor did respondent request verification that the document was actually not received by the complainant timely. The complainant did respond within the 20 days according to 52 Pa. Code, Section 5.333(a), after the Initial Decision was received.
3. The Exceptions were filed within the 20 day requirement, after being received via USPS, October 16, 2014 by the complainant. A letter was mailed along with the Exceptions document explaining the timeliness of the document. Regardless of this, the respondent insists, that the complainant should not be allowed to establish her own rules.
4. The respondent also found the need to file an undated, untimely document, Motion Nunc Pro Tunc, after the formal hearing, which was accepted and granted regardless of its timeliness, and with no explanation as to why the request was untimely, but feels complainant should not be afforded that same courtesy. That in the complainants circumstance it is simply making her own rules.

5. The respondent has repeatedly taken time to make or document unflattering statements regarding the complainant, but to date has not given any explanation as to why the respondent's representative acted in the manner that brought us to this point.

Wherefore, the complainant requests that her apology for the timeliness of the filed Exceptions please be accepted and the Exceptions be considered by the Commission. That the reason for the timeliness is that the document was received by the complainant on October 16, 2014. The Exceptions were filed as a result of the respondent's case being fully submitted, favored, and the complainant's request to enter supporting documentation was denied.
