In the next election, PA State Senator Tomlinson (Bensalem, PA) stated Ed Rendell was our greatest ally to obtain gambling in the state without the voter referendum. State Senators Tomlinson and Vince Fumo of Philadelphia were the two major political figures to support the gambling legislation without any voter input. State Senator Stewart Greenleaf however limited PA gaming to slot machines only. Subsequently Greenleaf's home burns down and a few days later Gov Rendell passed legislation to allow Casinos both Slots and Table Games. This seems to be a case of Jewish Lighting since Billions in Casino revenue were at stake. Greenleaf forgot his power brokers in www.BucksGop.org was the political power behind this legislation. State Senator Fumo was convicted on Public corruption issues. However his counter part Tomlinson appears to be an untouchable under the protection of the Bucks GOP. At the same time Rendell became PA Governor. Felon Asher and Bucks GOP Leader Fawkes selected Tom Corbett to become PA Attorney General. Former Pennsylvania Gov Ed Rendell first sponsored Casino Slot Machine Gaming without a Voter referendum. Bensalem State Senator Tom Tomlinson said “Rendell is our greatest ally for Slots without a Voter Referendum”. Subsequently Rendell again gave the Casino Industry Table Games without a voter referendum. In the debates for his first term Rendell said to the GOP candidate (Mike Fisher) “My God what is the GOP doing about Robert Asher?”. At the time when the legislation for Casino Table Games was being debated, the head of the PA Senate Judicial Committee Stewart Greenleaf was the hold out preventing the legislation. In early January of that year, Greenleaf’s home burned down in the middle of the night with the occupants just barely getting out with their lives. Three days later, Rendell signed the legislation to give PA Table games at the Casinos. Certainly sounds like a case of Jewish Lighting with Billions in Casino Gaming Revenue at stake. Like the JFK DA Specter and Sprague, Rendell started his career in the Philadelphia District Attorney’s office. Like Specter, Rendell lived in the housing Complex by the Inn of the Falls in Conshohocken PA. This was a track of exclusive homes that the Bootlegger Mafia of Conshohocken, PA used to compensate political figures.

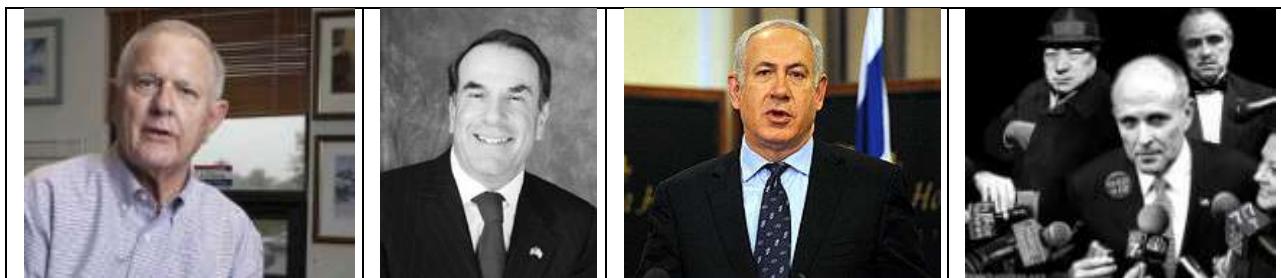


Figure 7 Asher DC Lobbyist for Duane Morris Nexus to Likud Friedman-Netanyahu and Giuliani

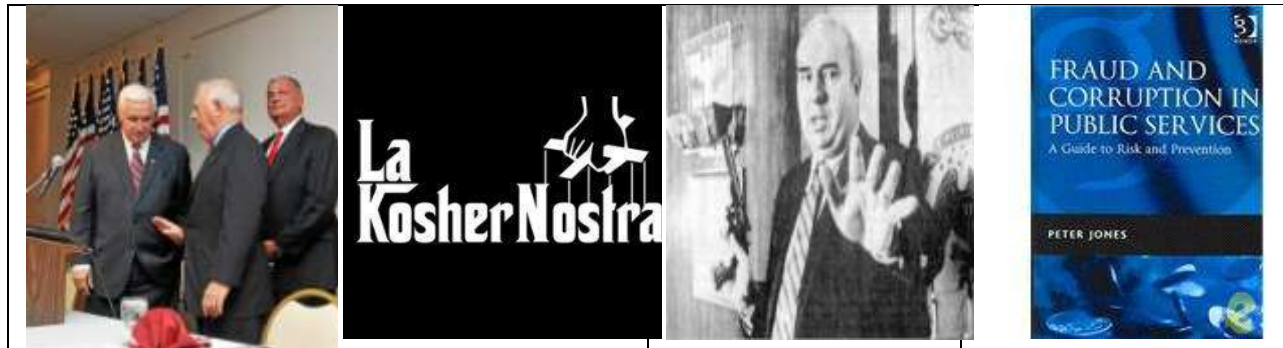


Figure 10 PA GOP Felon Returns to Montco GOP for PA Gov Corbett Election Campaign – Corbett, Kerns, Asher

Oct 25, 2013- Lower Gwynedd, Pennsylvania Republican Robert B. Asher, a GOP powerbroker on both the state and national levels, returned to an active role in Montgomery County GOP politics Thursday night. The announcement of Asher as co-chair of the organization's finance committee by a wide-smiling county GOP Chairman Robert J. Kerns drew warm applause from almost 300 party officials and foot soldiers gathered at the party's fall fundraising dinner at the Westover Golf Club in West Norriton. Kerns said that Asher's return and an agreement by Lower Merion Republican Vahan H. Gureghian, who has almost single handedly bankrolled the fractured, cash-strapped organization in recent years, to share his finance committee chairmanship with Asher shows the "new unity" of the county GOP. "I think some guys in leadership roles had different ideas on where we should be going but once everyone got together and talked, I think we are all united," said Kerns. Those talks, according to sources, occurred over six to eight months. State Rep. Mike Vereb, R-150, West Norriton, was instrumental in bringing Asher, a former chairman of both the county GOP and the state GOP, and Gureghian together. Until then the pair had an edgy, frosty relationship even though both were strong supporters of Gov. Tom Corbett. Ironically, Corbett was the party's "special guest" at the Thursday dinner but all the buzz was about Asher's return. Asher removed himself and the wallet of his well-funded Pennsylvania Future Fund political action committee from county politics in the early 2000s when Asher threw his support to Corbett over Bruce L. Castor Jr. in the pair's battle for the party's nomination for state Attorney General. A simmering feud between Asher, who served a year in jail following his federal conviction on political corruption charges, and both Castor and then-county GOP Chairman Frank Bartle became bitter, personal and very public at that juncture. **Gureghian, a non-practicing real estate lawyer who heads a**

charter school management firm and a billboard company, had long contributed to Lower Merion Republicans and their candidates as well as to state candidates but eventually stepped into the vacuum created when Asher withdrew from the county GOP. "There are no rearview mirrors on this organization," said Kerns. "We are moving forward together." "A lot of people said we should put the past behind us and unite and I was more than happy to do that," said Asher, who heads the family run Asher's Chocolates in Souderton. Asher said he and Gureghian will not have a problem working together. "We talked about it and we both want the same thing, which is unity in the Republican Party in Montgomery County," said Asher. "It's our common objective so I don't think there is going to be a bit of a problem." "We are a team," said Gureghian. "I've been a Republican for 40 years now and I can tell you that you can only win elections if you are a team. It is nice that we have finally been able to come together and work as a team." "My interest always has just been in the party," said Gureghian. "This is nothing but a positive. It's a shame it took this long." Missing from Thursday night's dinner was Castor, who turned 52 on Thursday. Castor, a county commissioner and former district attorney, could not be reached for comment after the dinner. Asked about Castor's role in the newly united county GOP, Kerns responded, "This is about party politics." "I would have no comment on the county commissioner," Asher said when asked the same question. Gureghian said Castor has two choices. "Either he is on the team or he is not on the team," said Gureghian. "He has to make that decision. After tonight, he sees where the team is." Corbett was one of those applauding the "new team." Corbett will need a united Montgomery County GOP if he stands any chance of winning the

county next year when he runs for re-election. Montgomery County, second only to Allegheny County in its number of registered GOP voters, in 2010 was only one of two counties where voters gave the nod to Democrat Dan Onorato in the governor's race. Statewide in 2010, Corbett received 54.9 percent of the vote to Onorato's 45.1 percent. Onorato walked away with Montgomery County in his pocket, receiving 51.71 percent of the vote to Corbett's 48.29 percent.

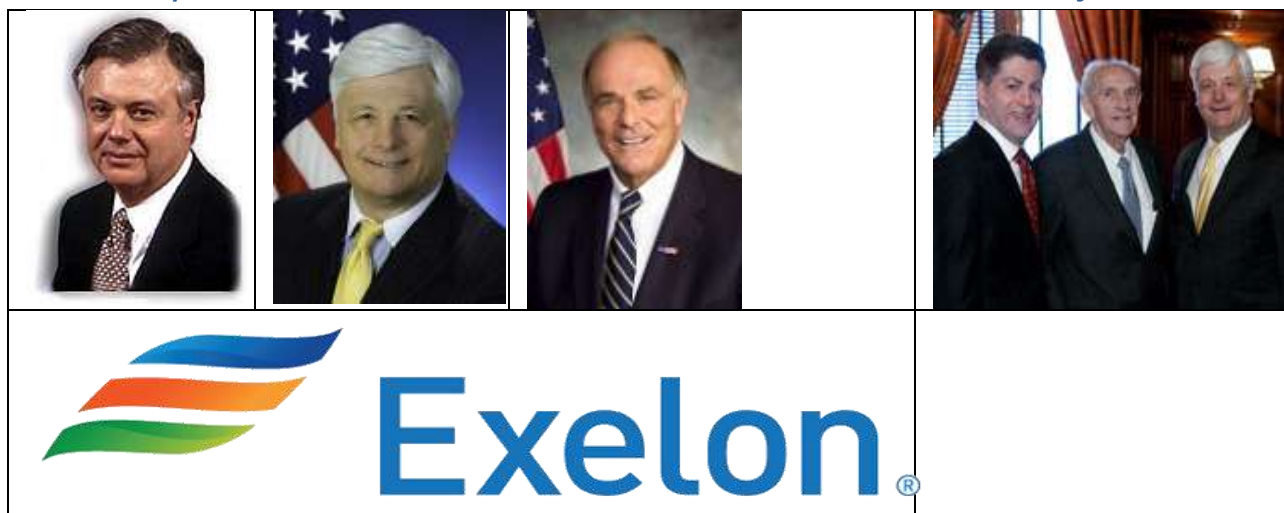

May 13, 2002 Computerworld - **Jeff Joerres** is chairman and CEO of Milwaukee-based Manpower Inc., an \$11.8 billion staffing services firm that counts among its clients 98 of the Fortune 100. He spoke last week with **Computerworld's** Don Tennant about some of the more controversial staffing issues facing IT professionals.

What's your response to the unemployed U.S. IT worker who resents the fact that the government is issuing H-1B visas to import IT talent? We have to continue it at a certain level, albeit maybe at a smaller one, but the visa policy must continue. We have to bring talent into the organization. [Unemployed U.S. IT workers] may not have the right skills. They may not have the mobility. When push comes to shove, they're not going to move to Des Moines. Someone from India might say, "I'm an SAP programmer; I'll move to Des Moines."

What's the most common IT staffing concern that you hear? That there is still a complete reluctance on the part of senior management to want to do anything with IT. There is still this Y2k hangover. I feel as though there is an attitude [among senior managers that] "IT is extremely important - it gives me an awful lot of savings. But I still can't feel that real trust that the money I'm putting in, which is always [increasing], is really coming back. So I'm going to hold off for a while."

6 Preliminary Summary

So nice for Convicted Felon Fumo to allow Exelon Peco Merger. Then have Exelon replace US IT labor via an exclusive contract with ManPower to replace US labor with Global IT Labor. So much for investment in the local community.
