Dear Mr. Swindler:

On May 31, 2005, pursuant to its Amended Streamlined Regulation and Network Modernization Plan (Chapter 30 Plan), ALLTEL Pennsylvania, Inc. (the Company) filed its annual Price Stability Index (PSI) and Service Price Index (SPI) Report. Accompanying the report were Supplement Nos. 245 and 246 to Tariff Telephone Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 to become effective July 30, 2005. Customers were notified of the proposed filings in their May 2005 bills.

- Supplement No. 245 utilizes banked revenues of \$1,450,979 resulting from a settlement of the Company's 2003 and 2004 PSI filing, of which \$239,925 will be continue to be banked.
- Supplement No. 246 incorporates PSI/SPI calculations in accord with the Company's Chapter 30 Plan resulting in a revenue increase of \$2,259,669.
- The combined impact produces a revenue increase of \$3,470,723 annually, including the banked amounts.


Over 1,100 rate elements are affected by the combined filings resulting in revised prices for services ranging from basic local service to optional calling features. Among the rate elements, the Company proposes to increase its Call Trace per activation rate from \$1.00 to \$1.50. The Commission grants this rate increase.

Commission Staff reviewed the filing, and suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time. Therefore, the filing will be permitted to become effective July 30, 2005, and **the Secretary's Bureau will mark this case closed**. This, however, does not constitute a determination that the tariff is just, lawful and reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, and is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against this tariff revision.
