**POST-HEARING ORDER**

This Order is issued in accordance with the provisions of 52 Pa. Code § 5.483 granting authority to presiding officers to regulate the course of proceedings. On November 18, 2013, Roger McCall (Complainant) filed a formal Complaint against Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec) alleging that Penelec had not read the meter at his residence correctly.

An Initial Telephonic Hearing convened on April 30, 2014. The Complainant participated by telephone and represented himself. Penelec was represented by Margaret A. Morris, Esquire, who also participated by telephone. After several minutes of discussion both on and off the record, it became clear that this case was not in a state to be heard, and therefore what had been scheduled as an evidentiary hearing was changed to a prehearing conference, only.

On December 3, 2014, an evidentiary (telephonic) hearing convened originating from the Commission's Harrisburg office. The Complainant participated by telephone and represented himself. Penelec was represented by Margaret A. Morris, Esquire. Towards the end of Penelec's case, attorney Morris requested permission to submit an additional hearing exhibit (Respondent's Exhibit 4) to the record.

I agreed to keep the record open for the receipt of Respondent's Exhibit 4 no later than December 4, 2014. Thereafter, Complainant will have until December 11, 2014 to make

any written response to Respondent's Exhibit 4. Respondent's counsel will then have until December 16, 2014 to address any issues raised by Complainant relative to Respondent's Exhibit 4. The parties should e-serve one another as well as the presiding officer. Two copies of Respondent's Exhibit 4 are to be provided to Commonwealth Reporting.

ORDER


THEREFORE;

1. That counsel for Pennsylvania Electric Company shall submit Respondent's Exhibit 4 no later than December 4, 2014. Thereafter, Complainant will have until December 11, 2014 to make any written response to Respondent's Exhibit 4. Respondent's counsel will then have until December 16, 2014 to address any issues raised by Complainant relative to Respondent's Exhibit 4.
