Dear Ms Paiva:

By letter dated July 24, 2007, Verizon Pennsylvania Inc., and Verizon North Inc. (collectively Verizon) filed documents intended to comply with our Order entered March 22, 2007 at Docket Nos. R-00051227 and R-00051228 (modified on reconsideration on April 25, 2007):

9. That Verizon Pennsylvania Inc. and Verizon North Inc. shall review, integrate, and edit each of their Amended Chapter 30 Plans so that those documents incorporate the pertinent information from the existing supplements into them so as **to ensure that the Plans contain only the language currently in effect.** Within ninety (90) days after the date of entry of a final Opinion and Order in this proceeding, Verizon Pennsylvania Inc. and Verizon North Inc. shall file revised Chapter 30 Plans, along with redlined copies, with the Commission for approval.¹ [emphasis added]



However, staff review indicates that the filing submitted by Verizon to incorporate pertinent information from all supplements to its Chapter 30 plan also contains language that goes beyond "the language currently in effect" as directed in ordering paragraph 9. Instead, Verizon appears to have incorporated proposed changes to its Chapter 30 plan for discussion purposes as a prelude to a petition for further amendment.

While the Commission is appreciative of Verizon's desire to discuss proposed changes to its currently effective Chapter 30 plan with the Commission and statutory agencies in a non-adversarial setting, the instant filing does not comply with ordering paragraph 9. Therefore, Verizon is directed to resubmit its compliance filing, along with redlined copies, omitting the pre-petition amendments, within 10 days of the date of this Secretarial Letter.

Please note that the 10-day period for filing exceptions to Verizon's compliance filing will commence on the date Verizon resubmits its compliance filings as directed in this Secretarial Letter.
