

JOINT PETITION

NOW COMES, Conestoga Telephone and Telegraph Company ("CTTC") and Nextel Communications of the Mid-Atlantic, Inc. ("Nextel") and respectfully submit to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") for approval, pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("TA-96") and the Commission's Order entered June 3, 1996, In Re: Implementation of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Docket No. M-00960799, the Commercial Mobile Radio Services Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") dated November 2004, a true and correct copy of which is attached. The Agreement provides for interconnection between the two companies, thereby facilitating Nextel's provision of commercial mobile radio service ("CMRS") to end user customers in Pennsylvania. CTTC is authorized to and hereby represents that Nextel has reviewed this petition and concurs herein. CTTC and Nextel therefore respectfully request that the Commission approve the Agreement. In support of this request, CTTC and Nextel state as follows:



DOCUMENT FOLDER

I. THE PARTIES

- CTTC is an incumbent local exchange carrier certified by the Commission to provide local exchange telecommunications services in Pennsylvania.
- Nextel is a telecommunications company authorized to provide CMRS service in Pennsylvania pursuant to authority granted by the Federal Communications Commission.

II. THE AGREEMENT

- 3. CTTC and Nextel have entered into this Agreement pursuant to Section 252(a) of TA-96 (47 U.S.C. §252(a)).
- 4. The Agreement sets forth the terms, conditions and prices under which CTTC and Nextel will offer and provide network interconnection, reciprocal call transport and termination and ancillary network services to each other. The Agreement is an integrated package that reflects a balancing of interests critical to the parties.

III. COMPLIANCE WITH TA-96

- 5. The Agreement satisfies the requirements for Commission approval pursuant to Section 252(e)(2)(A) of TA-96 (47 U.S.C. §252(e)(2)(A)), which provides as follows:
 - (2) GROUNDS FOR REJECTION.--The State commission may only reject . . .
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) if it finds that --

- (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
- (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity[.]
- 6. First, consistent with Section 252(e)(2)(a)(i), the Agreement does not discriminate against any other telecommunications carrier. To the contrary, the terms and conditions contained therein are available to any other telecommunications carrier in Pennsylvania willing and legally able to accept the Agreement. However, the applicability of the terms and conditions of this Agreement to other carriers may be limited to the extent that legal distinctions between CMRS traffic and non-CMRS traffic exist, including but not limited to, the differences in calling area. Other carriers are not bound by the Agreement and remain free to negotiate independently with CTTC pursuant to Section 252 of TA-96.
- 7. Second, the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity as required by Section 252(e)(2)(a)(ii). The Agreement permits Nextel to receive and provide reciprocal transport and termination benefiting Nextel's end user customers.

IV. APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT

8. On June 3, 1996, the Commission issued an Order in Docket No. M-00960799 establishing procedural guidelines for the implementation of TA-96, including the Commission's approval of negotiated interconnection agreements. In that Order, the Commission directed that an "A" docket be assigned by the Commission's Secretary at the time of the filing of an interconnection agreement if an "A" docket does not otherwise exist. We are unaware that any "A" docket exists for this matter at this time. Accordingly, the parties request the immediate assignment of an "A" docket number.

WHEREFORE, CTTC and Nextel respectfully request that the Commission approve the attached Commercial Mobile Radio Services Interconnection Agreement pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.


