Dear Ms. Chacko:

By Opinion and Order entered July 20, 1999, at Docket No. A-310801 F0002, the Commission approved the application of CoreComm Pennsylvania to provide service as a Facilities-Based Competitive Local Exchange Carrier to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed Pennsylvania P.U.C. Tariff P.S.C. No. 1 with an effective date of March 25, 1999.

CoreComm acquired the customers of USN Communications Atlantic, Inc. on May 26, 1999, pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement between CoreComm Limited and USN Communications, Inc, and by order of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court of the District of Delaware, in In re USN Communications, Inc., Case No. 99-383 (PJW) (D. Del. Apr. 2, 1999). Services provided to these former customers of USN are exclusively governed by the definitions, regulations, rates, terms and conditions contained in Section 10 Pennsylvania Tariff P.S.C. No. 1 with an effective date of January 3, 2000.

This letter is to notify you that this Tariff has been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariff is just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

The determination to permit this tariff to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariff.
