Re: GTC Telecom Application A-310810F0002  
To provide Competitive Local Exchange Carrier Service

Dear Mr. Mlinar:

On May 20, 2002, GTC Telecom Inc. ("GTC") filed an application for approval to provide telecommunications service as a reseller of Competitive Local Exchange Services (CLEC) in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. This authority would be in addition to the certificated interexchange (IXC) reseller services, at A-310810, previously approved for GTC. The Commission granted provisional authority to GTE for its CLEC operations, pending final approval of the application.

On August 4, 2003, the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter formally advising you about unresolved concerns regarding GTC's arrangements with 911 coordinators as well as notification via Certificate of Service upon the incumbent local exchange carriers in whose territory GTC intends to compete. At that time, we noted that it appeared GTC may not be prepared to offer service to the public and recommended GTC withdraw its application to avoid a Commission Order denying the application.


Because of the age of the application and apparent disregard in its lack of response to the staff, GTC is hereby informed that, unless we received the requested information by **February 2, 2004**, we will have no alternative but to immediately revoke GTC's provisional authority and prepare an Order for Commission approval to deny GTC's application.
