Dear Ms. Smith:

In conjunction with the Company's Application approved by the Commission Order entered on August 17, 1999, at the above referenced docketed filing, US LEC has filed the following compliance tariffs:

--Tariff-Telephone PA P.U.C. No. 1, Facilities-and-Non-Facilities-Based CLEC, to become effective February 1, 2000,

--Tariff-Telephone PA P.U.C. No. 2, Switched Access Services Tariff, to become effective February 2, 2000,

--Tariff-Telephone PA P.U.C. No. 3, Reseller of Toll Services Tariff, to become effective February 2, 2000, and,

--Tariff-Telephone PA P.U.C. No. 4, Facilities-Based IXC Tariff, to become effective February 2, 2000.

This letter is to notify you that the above tariffs have been permitted to become effective. However, this permission does not constitute a determination that the above tariffs are just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time. Furthermore, the determination to permit these tariffs to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against these tariffs.

It should also be noted that US LEC stated that it does not intend to initially offer residential basic local services and, therefore, these services have not been set forth in the above tariffs. US LEC also indicated that it would file appropriate residential tariff and the associated requirements when it determines to offer these services.
