
Re: Letter Petition to modify Certificate of Public Convenience of dPi Teleconnect, LLC, to operate as a facilities-based Competitive Local Exchange Carrier.

Dear Mr. Dorwart:

By Opinion and Order entered September 15, 1999, at Docket No. A-310804, the Commission approved the Application of DPI Teleconnect LLC. (Company) to provide Telecommunications services as a non-facilities based Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) within the service territories of Verizon PA., Verizon North, Inc., and Sprint/United Telephone Company. On January 13, 2003, the Company filed a letter petition requesting authority to expand its operations to also provide facilities-based CLEC services in the service areas in which it is currently authorized to operate. On September 12, 2003, the Company filed to amend the letter petition to also amend its Application and Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC). The Company intends to purchase both Bundled Elements and Unbundled Network Elements from Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers to provide services to residential customers in Pennsylvania.

This letter is to notify you that the Company's request to amend its CPC to expand the Company's CLEC operations to include facilities-based and resold CLEC services has been approved. The Company should contact Mr. Kerry Klinefelter of the Tariffs and Finance Section of the Bureau of Fixed Utility Services at (717) 787-2029 regarding Annual Report requirements. In addition, the Company should file Tariff Telephone Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 to offer Switched Access services, to become effective on one (1) day's notice from the date upon which it is filed and served. Upon approval of the Switched Access Tariff, a Certificate of Public Convenience shall be issued evidencing authority to provide services as a facilities-based and non-facilities based Competitive Local Exchange Carrier in the service territories of Verizon Pennsylvania Inc., Verizon North Inc. and Sprint/United Telephone Company of Pennsylvania.
