
On behalf of Ironton Telephone Company ("Ironton"), we write to formally request that Omnipoint Comm. Inc. ("T-Mobile") join Ironton in good faith negotiations under 47 C.F.R. § 252 to establish an interconnection agreement between the two entities. This letter begins the specific timelines set forth in § 252. It should be noted that your company was previously billed by Verizon-Pennsylvania for terminating traffic to Ironton. Any negotiated agreement shall be effective as of the date these payments ceased.

This request for negotiation is made pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 20.11(f) as recently adopted by the Federal Communications Commission. See Developing a Unified Intercarrier Compensation Regime, CC Docket No. 01-92, *Declaratory Ruling and Report and Order*, FCC 05-42 (released February 24, 2005). This request for negotiations is made without waiver of or prejudice to any or all of Ironton's rights and remedies at law or in equity, all of which are expressly reserved.

Ironton is a rural incumbent local exchange carrier that operates in Pennsylvania. By requesting negotiation of a compensation agreement, in no way does Ironton intend to waive any of its rights, including, but not limited to, those provided under 47 U.S.C. § 251(f).

The Company has developed a proposed Traffic Exchange and Compensation Agreement which we could use as an opening document.
