On February 9, 2000, xDSL Networks, Inc. ("xDSL") informed the Commission that it has ceased its operations and requested that the provisional authority granted to xDSL to provide telecommunication services in Pennsylvania be cancelled. xDSL also informed the Commission that the Company has never served any customers in Pennsylvania and that no NXX codes were allocated to xDSL.


The Commission has not approved xDSL's application for authority to provide telecommunication services in Pennsylvania. However, the Company has had the provisional authority to provide telecommunication services in Pennsylvania. As such, there is no need for issuing a certificate of public convenience authorizing the discontinuation and abandonment of service by xDSL, pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §1102(a)(2).

You are hereby notified that the Commission permits the application of xDSL to be withdrawn and to cancel the provisional authority granted to xDSL.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.44, file a petition with the Commission within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
