Dear Ms. Byrnes:

By Order entered September 20, 1999, at Docket Nos. A-310828 F0002 and A-310828 F0003, the Commission approved the application of Fibernet Telecommunications Services of Pa., LLC., Inc. to provide service as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier and as a Competitive Access Provider to businesses in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed PA PUC Tariff Telephone Nos. 2 and No. 3, with effective dates of September 21, 2001, and November 23, 2001, respectively. The Company has also filed, as part of its CLEC authority, Switched Access Tariff No. 4.

This letter is to notify you that the CLEC Tariffs Nos. 2 and 4 and the CAP Tariff No. 3 have been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariffs are just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

The determination to permit the tariffs to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariffs.
