By Order entered October 4, 1999, at Docket Nos. A-310832 and A-310832F0002, the Commission approved the application of Computer Business Sciences, Inc., for approval to offer, render, furnish, or supply telecommunication services to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 1, to offer Competitive Local Exchange Carrier services, Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 2, to offer Interexchange Carrier services, and Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 3, to offer Switched Access services, each with the effective date of April 3, 2000.

This letter is to notify you that Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 1, Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 2, and Tariff Telephone-PA P.U.C. No. 3 have been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariffs are just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

The determination to permit these tariffs to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariffs.
