DOCUMENT ORDER
BY THE COMMISSION:

Voice Vision International, Inc. (Applicant) filed the above-captioned Application on May 20, 1999, seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience pursuant to Sections 1101, *et seq.*, of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1101, *et seq.*, evidencing Commission approval to resell interexchange (IXC) telecommunication services to residential and business customers throughout Pennsylvania.

The Applicant complied with Section 5.14 of our Regulations, 52 Pa. Code §5.14, relating to applications requiring notice. No protests were filed, and no hearings were held. Furthermore, no motions or petitions have been filed in the proceeding.

The Applicant is a foreign corporation, with its principal place of business at 5959 W. Century Blvd., Suite 1020, Los Angeles, CA. 90045. The Applicant provided proof of compliance with 15 Pa. C.S. §4124, relating to a foreign corporation. Correspondence to resolve complaints should be directed to Lamia Elawar, Customer Service Manager, at the Applicant's principal place of business. The Applicant's commercial registered office provider is C T Corporation System, Philadelphia, PA.

The Applicant proposes to operate as a non-facilities based reseller of IXC telecommunications services within the Commonwealth. Specifically, the Applicant proposes to operate as a reseller of toll services, including outbound 1+ and 101xxxx dialing, inbound "800" and "888" toll free, travel card, and debit card services.

The Applicant has filed a Proposed Tariff, which contains rates in compliance with Section 63.114 of our Regulations, 52 Pa. Code §63.114, relating to maximum rates for resellers of IXC telecommunications services.

Based upon our review of the subject Application and the Proposed Tariff, we conclude that the Applicant has met all the requirements for certification as a reseller of IXC telecommunication services in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Furthermore, the Applicant's proposed services do not raise concerns at this time regarding safety, adequacy, reliability or privacy as contemplated by Section 3009(b)(4) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §3009 (b)(4). We note, however, a deficiency in the Proposed Tariff. See Appendix A. We shall direct the Applicant to revise the Proposed Tariff accordingly.

The Applicant shall file its Initial Tariff reflecting rules and rates consistent with this Order with the Tariff Section of the Commission on or before sixty (60) days from the date of entry of this Order. Copies of the Initial Tariff will also be served upon the entities receiving service of the original Application. The Initial Tariff may become effective on or after (1) day's notice from the date upon which it is filed with the Tariff Section.

If the Applicant expects to exceed the sixty (60) day requirement, the Applicant may request one extension of an additional sixty (60) days with the Commission's Secretary. Thus, if the Initial Tariff is not filed within 60 days (120 days if an extension is requested) of the date of entry of this Order, the authority granted herein will be revoked and the Application will be dismissed without further Commission Order; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Application of Voice Vision International, Inc., filed on May 20, 1999, at Docket No. 310831, for approval to resell interexchange telecommunications services to residential and business customers throughout Pennsylvania is approved.

2. That the Applicant shall file its Initial Tariff, consistent with requisite changes noted in Appendix A of this Order, with the Tariff Section of the Commission within sixty (60) days after the date of entry of this Order and have a copy served on each entity receiving a copy of the original Application. The Initial Tariff may become effective on or after one (1) days notice from the date upon which it filed with the Tariff Section. The Initial Tariff must reflect on its face that it is an "Interexchange Reseller Toll Tariff".

3. That the Applicant shall comply with all the provisions of the Public Utility Code, as now exist or as may be hereafter amended, and with all pertinent Rules, Regulations, and Orders of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, now in effect or as may be prescribed by the Commission. Failure to comply will be sufficient cause to suspend, revoke or rescind the rights and privileges which are conferred hereby.


4. That the authority granted herein, to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the Applicant, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right to the Applicant.

5. That, upon the establishment of filed rates and the approval of an Initial Tariff, a Certificate of Public Convenience be issued authorizing the Applicant to furnish interexchange telecommunication services within the Commonwealth as a non-facilities-based interexchange reseller, consistent with this Order.

6. That in the event the Applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days (or 120 days if the Applicant requests an extension in writing) from the date of entry of this Order, complied with the requirements set forth herein, the Application at Docket No. A-310831 may be dismissed without any further proceeding and the

authority granted herein be revoked without further Commission Order.
