**ORDER #2 SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

A hearing in this matter is currently scheduled for July 25, 2007, pursuant to Revised Procedural Order #3. On July 16, 2007, I received notice that the parties had reached a settlement of all issues in these consolidated proceedings, but would need some time to draft the settlement documents. After consultation with the parties, I determined that it was appropriate to suspend the procedural schedule, indicated in the Revised Procedural Order #3, cancel the July 25, 2007 hearing, and establish a deadline for the filing of the Settlement Petition, with attached Statements in Support.

I will direct that the parties provide a settlement petition, with attached statements in support from, at a minimum, Verizon Pennsylvania, Inc. (Verizon) and Verizon North, Inc.

(Verizon North) and all parties filing Formal Complaints, no later than close of business on Wednesday, August 8, 2007. The settlement petition and all attachments must be provided to the presiding officer in both an electronic version (if possible, in Word 2003) and hard copy, and if these documents contain proprietary material, a non-proprietary version must also be supplied. In addition, the settlement petition must be supported by facts contained in prepared testimony and/or factual stipulations which will be made a part of the record. Verizon and Verizon North have agreed to supply their currently effective Chapter 30 Plans (both red-lined and clean copies) by July 25, 2007, and I will include these documents in the record when received.

I will further request that the settlement petition include, if possible, examples demonstrating the operation of the proposed banking settlement for Verizon.

A transcribed telephonic conference call may be scheduled after the filing of the settlement petition, but prior to August 20, 2007, to address questions which the presiding officer may have regarding the settlement.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the procedural schedule indicated in Revised Procedural Order #3, dated June 20, 2007, is hereby suspended and the July 25, 2007 hearing cancelled due to a complete settlement among the parties of all issues.

2. That a settlement petition and attached statements in support from, at a minimum, Verizon, Verizon North, and all parties filing formal complaints, be prepared and provided to the presiding officer by close of business on Wednesday, August 8, 2007. The settlement petition and all attachments must be provided to the presiding officer in both an electronic version (if possible, in Word 2003) and hard copy. An electronic version will be

accepted as meeting the in-hand requirement, if followed the next day by a hard copy. If these documents contain proprietary material, a non-proprietary version must also be supplied.

3. That the parties provide record support of the necessary facts to support the settlement petition, either through stipulation of fact, admission of testimony by stipulation, or other appropriate means. In addition, the banking settlement must be accompanied by examples of the proposed methodology, to the extent possible.
