

**PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION'S
REPLIES TO EXCEPTIONS OF COMPLAINANT**

AND NOW comes the Respondent, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL"), by and through its attorneys of record, Gross McGinley, LLP, and files the within Replies to Exceptions, alleging in support thereof as follows:

1. Denied. On November 24, 2014, Administrative Law Judge Susan D. Colwell, issued an Initial Decision in the above captioned action. The Decision was then issued on all parties on December 17, 2014. Any Exceptions were due on or before January 6, 2015 and Replies due on or before January 16, 2015. Complainant mailed a letter to Secretary Rosemary Chiavetta on or about December 26, 2014. The letter is not identified as "Exceptions" and is not in the required format for "Exceptions." However, in an abundance of caution, and in the event the Commission accepts the December 26, 2014, correspondence as Exceptions, PPL Electric files the within Reply.

Complainant appears to express concern in his correspondence that PPL Electric had previously issued a disconnect order despite a monthly payment. The uncontradicted evidence of record is that Complainant has defaulted on nineteen (19) PPL Electric issued payment arrangements, (N.T. at 16) and had last made any payment on August 20, 2014.


(N.T. at 13). (A payment had been issued by LIHEAP in October 2014). (PPL Hearing Exhibit 1). In addition, Complainant's balance at the time of the hearing was \$9,087.07. (PPL Hearing Exhibit 1) Moreover, there is no evidence that PPL Electric interrupted Complainant's service.

Complainant appears to request an overall review of his entire case. Such request is not warranted. Complainant's service was not interrupted at any time, and no claim to the contrary has been asserted. In addition, the most advantageous payment arrangement available to a customer is five (5) years. 66 Pa.C.S. § 1405(b)(1). Despite Complainant defaulting on nineteen (19) PPL Electric issued payment arrangements, PPL Electric did not oppose, and the ALJ granted Complainant, a Commission Ordered payment arrangement of five years. Accordingly, Complainant has received the most advantageous payment arrangement to which any customer is entitled.

For the foregoing reasons, it is respectfully requested that the Commission deny Complainant's Exceptions.


