Dear Mr. Romaine:

By Order entered April 1, 2002, at Docket Nos. A-310923, A-310923 F0002, A-310923 F0003 and A-310923 F0004 the Commission approved the application of Adelphia Business Solutions Operations, Inc to provide service, as a Reseller of Interexchange Toll Services, as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier, as a Competitive Access Provider and as a Facilities-based Interexchange Toll Carrier to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed PA PUC Tariff Telephone No.s' 1, 2 4, and 5 with an effective date of August 6 2002. In compliance to the aforementioned Commission Order, the Company has filed Switched Access Tariff No. 3, effective August 6, 2002, as part of its CLEC authority.

This letter is to notify you that the IXC Reseller Tariff No. 1, the CLEC Tariff No. 2, the CAP Tariff No. 4 and the IXC Toll Carrier Tariff No. 5 have been permitted to become effective. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariffs are just, lawful, or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time.

The determination to permit the tariffs to become effective is without prejudice to any complaint timely filed against the proposed tariffs.
