
Dear Judge Johnson,

I have received my Prehearing Orders in the mail. My case number is F-2014-2444958. The case involves a dispute of charges against PECO Energy Company. Currently the date is set for Wednesday, January 21<sup>st</sup> 2015, at 10:00 a.m.

I'm writing you today to request that my hearing be re-scheduled to a later date due to me being out of the country from Friday, January 9<sup>th</sup> 2014 to Wednesday, January 21<sup>st</sup> 2015. This family vacation was scheduled months ago, and on January 21<sup>st</sup>, I will be coming back from international waters with no access to the internet or cell phone service. Nor will I have my supporting documents in my possession during the currently scheduled date and time.

Furthermore, upon reviewing the "Prehearing Orders", item # 12 references the Commission's policy which urges the utility provider to call the customer at least one week before the scheduled hearing in hopes of settling the case before it goes to a formal hearing. If this happens, I will not receive the call due to being in the middle of international waters with no cellular service. If possible, I would very much like to come to an amicable resolution without resorting to a formal hearing on this matter.
