NORESCO also enters into a broker agreement with the supplier which agrees to remit the agreed-upon broker fee from the customer to NORESCO for any customer NORESCO refers. Once the customer and the supplier have entered into an electricity sales agreement, the customer remits the broker fee to the supplier, and the broker fee s remitted by supplier to NORESCO in regular (usually monthly installments). Payment by the supplier to NORESCO of the broker fee is contingent upon the supplier receiving payment from the customer.


