Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In compliance with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") Order entered January 15, 2015 at Docket No. P-2014-2417907 ("January 15 Order"), enclosed for filing please find the following documents on behalf of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric" or the "Company"):

- Revised Default Service Supply Master Agreement ("DS SMA")
- Revised Default Service Request for Proposal Process and Rules ("DS RFP")
- Alternative Energy Credits Supply Master Agreement ("AEC SMA")
- Alternative Energy Credits Request for Proposals Process and Rules ("AEC RFP")
- Pro Forma Revised Tariff Pages

As explained further below, in accordance with the terms of the Joint Petition for Approval of Partial Settlement ("Partial Settlement"), which was adopted by the January 15 Order, the first procurement under this Default Service Procurement Plan must be completed in time to file June 1, 2015 Default Service rates with the Commission by May 1, 2015. Therefore, the Company

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requests that the Commission approve the enclosed documents by February 27, 2015 in order to provide sufficient time for PPL Electric to undertake the pre-solicitation activities necessary to hold a solicitation in mid-April.

As indicated on the attached certificate of service, copies of this compliance filing have been served on all parties of record.

DS SMA and DS RFP

The DS SMA and DS RFP are the pro forma DS SMA and DS RFP that were included as part of PPL Electric's Petition filed on or about April 18, 2014, revised to reflect the terms of the Partial Settlement and the results of the Commission's decision on the reserved issues set forth in the January 15 Order. These revisions include changes to comply with settlement paragraphs 22, 23, 25, 26, 28, 31 and 37 through 43. The documents also reflect the change in the demarcation between small and large commercial and industrial customers from 500 kW to 100 kW, as proposed by PPL Electric and adopted by the Commission in its January 15 Order.

AEC SMA and AEC RFP

Paragraph 29 of the Partial Settlement provides for the procurement of certain Tier I (non-solar) and Tier II AECs through new individual long-term contracts, to be solicited in the first auction to be held in mid-April under the DS Procurement Plan.

To accomplish this procurement, PPL Electric has prepared a separate AEC SMA and AEC RFP. These documents are patterned off of documents previously approved by the Commission and used in a prior default service plan period to procure certain Tier I solar AECs. The documents have been modified, as applicable, to conform with terms of the current DS SMA and DS RFP and the Partial Settlement.


Pro Forma Tariff Pages

Also enclosed are pro forma tariff pages to implement the terms of the Partial Settlement and the January 15 Order. These pages are provided in redline format, reflecting changes from PPL Electric's currently-effective tariff. These changes reflect revisions to conform with Paragraphs 30, 33-36 and 52 of the Partial Settlement, and the results of the Commission's January 15 Order. *The Company notes that it is submitting these pro forma tariff pages for approval as being in compliance with the Partial Settlement and January 15 Order. However, the pages are not being submitted as a tariff supplement at this time, because the terms are applicable for service beginning June 1, 2015. In accordance with the Partial Settlement, a tariff supplement will be submitted on or about May 1, 2015, for rates to be effective June 1, 2015.*
