
Dear Judge Watson:

Saturday morning, **December 20, 2014**, a man knocked at the door somewhere between 10:30 A.M. and 10:40 A.M. He was from PECO, and came without any forewarning. When my wife (Margaret Huh) asked, he explained he came here to install a new electric meter at our home. He further explained to my wife that the old meters were antenna-based and broadcast the meter reading to a pole, which then went to PECO via a landline. The **new meters** are like a cell phone, 900 megahertz, and send the meter reading directly to PECO.

This is the same meter that was installed on many of the other houses on Hoffman Drive on **Friday, March 14, 2014**, when our house was **deliberately skipped**. My wife asked the man how come we are getting this meter now when other houses on Hoffman Drive got it earlier this year, and he did not give any answer.

As a result of the aforesaid incident, we are officially reporting the same to you in connection with our complaint filed with the Public Utility Commission as before.
