I received a letter from your office on January 27, 2015, stating that I have failed to maintain proper insurance on my trucks.

The reasons are as follows:

- 1) Son, who drove for me was deployed by U.S. Air Force to the Middle East. (His truck had remained parked for the entire year of 2014.)
- 2) Myself (Robert Fousman), I was unable to drive for medical reasons.
- 3) I took work for a construction company close to home in order to acquire health insurance.
- 4) My finances were greatly reduced and it became near impossible to maintain insurance and license on two trucks that have been parked for the entire year.
- 5) Another truck has been used without proper license and insurance.

6) Recently switched one truck to farm use only tags.

7) Son has returned from deployment and he would like to drive again. - We have tried to follow the proper channels to obtain license and insurance again on this truck (truck he drives for us) in 2015.

I may have been negligent in returning the license to the state; but I tried to maintain insurance throughout the year, as I was able. It was not my intention to let the license expire, but due to circumstances I was unable to afford all the costs involved.

Again I will state the trucks were not used to haul anything under PUC's jurisdiction for the year of 2014.
