PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER


A prehearing conference pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.224 will be held on February 28, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. I will preside from a hearing room in Pittsburgh and the Harrisburg parties will participate in a hearing room in Harrisburg. In preparation for the prehearing conference, please submit to me, and serve on all parties, a prehearing conference memorandum. Your prehearing conference memorandum must be in my hands and the hands of the other parties by 4:00 p.m. on February 26, 2007. Please include the following in your prehearing conference memorandum:

- (1) the status of any settlement discussions;
- (2) the status of discovery;
- (3) proposed discovery rules (I have the parties call each other if there are objections and call me for a telephone ruling only if they cannot resolve the dispute);
- (4) a proposed schedule for discovery;
- (5) any admissions or stipulations;
- (6) the factual issues to be addressed in this case;
- (7) the legal issues to be addressed in this case;
- (8) the names, titles and business addresses of each witness;
- (9) the issues each witness will address;
- (10) a proposed date for a second prehearing conference, if necessary;
- (11) a proposed schedule for the submission of written testimonies;

- (12) a proposed schedule for evidentiary hearings;
- (13) a proposed schedule and proposed places for any public input hearings;
- (14) a proposed briefing schedule;
- (15) any other pertinent information.

The procedural schedule that you propose must conclude with any reply briefs no later than April 30, 2007. Tentative hearing dates are April 3-5, 2007.
