1. An in person further hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Wednesday, March 11, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.
2. PECO is requesting a continuance of the March 11<sup>th</sup> hearing date because of the unavailability of PECO witness, Senior Regulatory Assessor, Teresa Ferrier.
3. Ms. Ferrier, along with PECO's team of Regulatory Assessors, is scheduled to travel to Harrisburg, PA to attend PUC budget hearings.
