ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on applications filed by sixty (60) currently certificated carriers seeking emergency temporary authority to provide limousine service between points in Allegheny County.

The applications for emergency temporary authority were filed to comply with our order at M-00021609, adopted April 11, 2002, entered April 15, 2002. That order established procedures to Implement HB 1402, which extended the Commission's regulatory jurisdiction in Allegheny County, to include motor carriers providing limousine service.

The procedure outlined in the order at M-00021609 required all carriers desiring to provide limousine service between points in Allegheny County to file an emergency temporary authority application within sixty (60) days of the entry date of the order (April 15, 2002). The sixty (60) carriers identified in the Appendix made part of this order filed timely applications. The applications have been reviewed and a determination has been made that they conform to the requirements enumerated in our order of April 11, 2002.

As currently certificated carriers, there is a presumption that the carriers are fit, and that they stand ready, willing and able to provide service in Allegheny County. As currently certificated carriers, they all have Form E evidence of insurance on file with the Commission.

Each of the carriers submitted a proposed rate structure for service in Allegheny County or have incorporated by reference their rates currently on file with the Commission. The rates contained in the applications for emergency temporary authority are hereby approved expressly for the purpose of providing service under a grant of emergency temporary authority.

The grant of emergency temporary authority by this order shall be effective for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of entry of the order. All carriers granted emergency temporary authority by this order are required to file an application for permanent authority within thirty (30) days of the entry date. The filing of an application for permanent authority within thirty (30) days will automatically extend the emergency temporary authority pending disposition of the permanent authority application.

Failure to file a permanent authority application within thirty (30) days of the date of entry of this order will require the filing of applications for emergency temporary authority, temporary authority and/or permanent authority in full compliance with the regulations at 52 Pa Code §§ 3.381 through 3.385.

After complete review of the record, we find:

1. Applicants seek a grant of emergency temporary authority to provide limousine service in Allegheny County.
2. Applicants are currently certificated carriers with Form E evidence of insurance on file.
3. Applicants have proposed rates for service under a grant of emergency temporary authority which are approved for that express purpose.
4. Applicants have the appropriate equipment, the experience, and fitness necessary to render the service.
5. The grant of emergency temporary authority is effective immediately.
6. Approval of the applications is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED: That the applications be and are hereby approved, granting the following right effective immediately:

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in limousine service between points in Allegheny County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the approval of emergency temporary authority shall become effective upon entry of the instant order and shall remain in effect for a period of thirty (30) days unless extended as provided below.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That should the carrier file an application for permanent authority within thirty (30) days of the date of entry of the instant order, the emergency temporary authority will automatically extend pending disposition of the permanent authority application.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That should the applicant fail to file a permanent authority application within thirty (30) days of the date of entry of the instant order, the applicant shall cease and desist from providing limousine service in Allegheny County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That failure to file an application for permanent authority within thirty (30) days of the date of entry of this order will require the filing of new application for emergency temporary authority, temporary authority, and permanent authority in compliance with 52 Pa. Code §§ 3.383 and 3.384.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That our decision in these applications for emergency temporary authority shall have no bearing on our decision in the applications for permanent authority.
