In response to the above-mentioned complaint, be advised that there was no deliberate intent to fail to maintain evidence of Liability and Cargo Insurance coverage and to have such evidence filed with the Public Utility Commission.

WARREN TRUCKING INC. had made numerous attempts to obtain the necessary insurance coverage. However, the exorbitant costs of the necessary insurance coverage available would have caused extreme financial hardship.

Consequently, WARREN TRUCKING INC ceased operations on November 30, 2014, refrained from operating the vehicle, and proceeded to sell the vehicle on December 1, 2014.

Therefore, cancellation of the Certificate of Public Convenience was a necessary consequence of the unsuccessful attempts to obtain the appropriate insurance coverage to continue to operate and there was no need to pursue a filing with the Public Utility Commission.

There was no alleged illegal activity and this correspondence contests the alleged Complaint, the alleged violation, and the unnecessary imposed penalty.
