RE: Request to make a Powerpoint Presentation

Honorable Judge Fordham:

I indicated in the pre-hearing Conference in November, 2014, that I would like to present evidence using Powerpoint presentation software. This would allow me to display specific bills with their aberrations, inconsistencies, and errors. The presentation would also be available to the Court in full hard copy. In his Interrogatories (PPL to Moyer 1-8), Mr. Cannon requested that I explain in detail the discrepancies between my bills and their "calculation sheets" or "separate tabulations".

My Written Testimony (pp. 30-34) already includes 27 specific cases of error, irregularity, and discrepancy in PPL's billing procedures. Although the list was not exhaustive, most of these were not answered by Mr. Cannon. These and other specific examples are difficult to demonstrate in the narrative form prescribed for Written Direct Testimony. The Powerpoint Presentation would also provide a concise and visual recapitulation of my Written Testimony.

I have no interest in presuming on the Court or in committing any breach of procedure. I'm writing, therefore, to follow up on my request in the pre-hearing conference and ask that I be permitted to open the Hearing with that Powerpoint presentation, which will not exceed 90 minutes.

In hope of being afforded a full presentation of the evidence, I look forward to a prompt and favorable reply to my request.
