- 1.) The name and address of the applicant is Verizon Pennsylvania LLC located at 15 E. Montgomery Ave. 2nd Floor, Right of Way Dept., Pittsburgh, PA 15212.

- 3.) Verizon Pennsylvania LLC wishes to contstruct/upgrade a fiber optic cable crossing in the Borough of Punxsutawney, Jefferson County. To complete this work, we must cross Buffalo & Pittsburgh Railroad, Inc., in the public right of way of State Route 3021 North Findley Street, Crossing #149-892N. Projected start date of this project is April 15, 2015.
- 4.) The proposed construction is a Fiber Optic Cable placement, 120 foot span, being attached to Verizon Pole 111-15 to Verizon Pole 111-16. New fiber optic cable to be lashed to a 10m (10000 lb) Messenger. Proposed completion date for this project is July 31, 2015
- 5.) The public utilities, municipalities, corporations and property owners concerned in, or affected by the crossing alterations are identified in Exhibit "B" attached hereto.
- 6.) The proposed construction will have no impact on motoring or rail traffic. Verizon Pennsylvania LLC will use normal construction procedures including the use of flagmen to maintain the normal flow of traffic. Verizon Pennsylvania LLC's normal construction procedure includes the use of warning devices and flagmen when necessary, to maintain, as nearly as possible the normal flow of vehicular traffic. Estimated cost of the construction is \$1,000.00.

- 7). Verizon Pennsylvania LLC will pay all costs of the proposed construction.
- 8). The alterations at this crossing are necessary for: Verizon Pennsylvania LLC to provide additional interoffice capacity between Punxsutawney and Reynoldsville central offices.


