
By Order entered November 9, 2001, at Docket Nos. A-311102, A-311102F0002, A-311102F0003 and A-311102F0004 the Commission approved the application of Dominion Telecom, Inc. to provide service as a Reseller of Interexchange Toll Services, Reseller of Competitive Local Exchange Carrier, Competitive Access Service and Facilities-Based Interexchange Toll Services to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The Company has filed PA P.U.C. Tariff No. 1, PA P.U.C. Tariff No. 2, PA P.U.C. Tariff No. 3 and PA P.U.C. Tariff No. 4 respectively with effective dates of December 27, 2001.
