Dear Secretary,

The Energy Cooperative Association of Pennsylvania d/b/a The Energy Co-op (“The Energy Co-op”) was granted a license by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply Natural Gas Services to the Public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on July 24, 2014 in Docket A-2014-20142409507. At this time, they would like to amend their initial license to include the Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) service territory. As indicated in Section 11, The Energy Co-op plans to offer service to residential and commercial customers.

Included with this submission is revised application page 5 to reflect The Energy Co-op natural gas supplier license number, and page 6 with updated Section 10 reflecting the requested additional service territory. Also included is a copy of a letter from PGW confirming that The Energy Co-op has met current credit requirements and proof of service indicating a copy of this filing has been provided to the Office of Consumer Advocate, Office of the Attorney General, Office of the Small Business Advocate, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Revenue and PGW. The Energy Co-op previously posted notice of their intent to serve customers in PECO’s service territory in the Philadelphia Daily News as required by the PUC when they filed their original application.

Re: Security Requirement for PGW.

Mr. Clay Bedwell:

Philadelphia Gas Works ("PGW") is aware that Energy Cooperative Association of Pennsylvania has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas services to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the services territory of Philadelphia Gas Works.

As you know, in making such an application, Energy Cooperative Association of Pennsylvania must furnish acceptable security to each utility where Energy Cooperative Association of Pennsylvania will do business. As such, under its tariff, Philadelphia Gas Works could require Energy Cooperative Association of Pennsylvania to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that Philadelphia Gas Works determines to be appropriate.

However, since you just beginning the process with the PAPUC and the Philadelphia Gas Works' to become a supplier, the Philadelphia Gas Works at this time will not require any type of bond or Security.

If circumstances should change during the vetting of the application, Philadelphia Gas Works reserves the right to require security from Energy Cooperative Association of Pennsylvania as it deems appropriate.
