Justification for Safety Valve Waiver

The additional numbering resources are required to permit Windstream to provide service via new packet switches that are being deployed to support projects supported by the Federal Communications Connect America Fund Phase I (“CAF1”) in the Enon Valley and Sligo, Pennsylvania rate centers. According to the applicable industry *Location Routing Number (LRN) Assignment Practices document (ATIS-0300065)* Windstream must establish a unique LRN to identify the recipient switch or POI and must establish a LRN per LATA per switch from an assigned NXX for the recipient switch in the number portability capable network. Thus, Windstream must obtain a LRN for each new packet switch. Also pursuant to industry guidelines, only a NXX code holder can obtain a LRN, thus necessitating Windstream’s request for a NXX code, for this rate center. (It should be noted, however, that Windstream would retain only a single thousand-number-block from the new NXX code.)

Windstream has demonstrated a verifiable need as Windstream will be unable to port numbers to the new packet switches or to provide new services using the switch.

Windstream cannot satisfy the need for numbering resources from its current inventory or in any other manner and has exhausted all other available remedies.

Granting Windstream’s request will not adversely affect the numbering resources available for use by carriers throughout the state in providing telecommunications services to their customers. Granting Windstream’s request is in the public interest and consistent with the FCC’s rules and decisions.

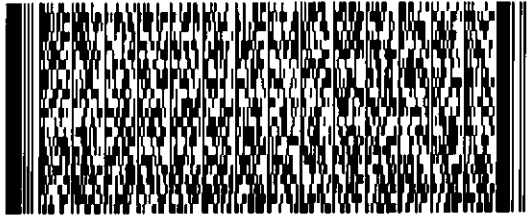

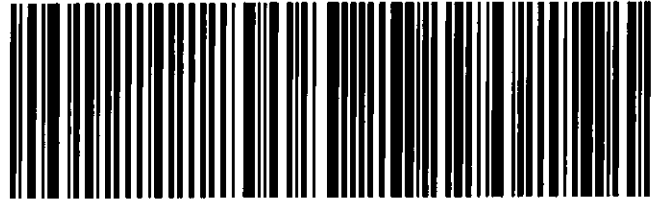
