Dear Sir or Madam:

Please be advised that on March 14, 2002, the Commission approved the application of Freedomstarr Communications, Inc. for authority to offer telecommunications services as a Reseller of Interexchange Toll Services in Pennsylvania. As of this date, the tariffs necessary to implement this service have not been filed with the Commission, nor do we have any record of your company contacting the staff regarding this matter.

The Commission's Order gave you 60 calendar days in which to file the applicable tariffs. It now having been more than 60 calendar days since the Commission's action, your company seems to have abandoned its request for authority to offer the above-mentioned service. *The provisional authority granted in the Order of March 14, 2002, will be rescinded 30 days from the date of this letter if the tariff/s necessary to resolve this matter is/are not timely filed.*
