That no right, power or privilege is granted to provide service from points within the counties of Lycoming, Northumberland, Union, Montour, Centre, Columbia and Luzerne, to points throughout the Commonwealth.

SECTION 1
RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS IN USE, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No.53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound, per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 30 - TOLLS

Any tolls incurred during the course of your move will be billed back to you. Please keep in mind that tolls for commercial vehicles are often more expensive than tolls for passenger cars.

ITEM 40 - PARKING TICKETS

Any parking tickets incurred during the course of a move will be billed back to the customer.

SECTION 2
ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 200 - PIANO FEE

There will be an additional one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollar fee assessed for moving a piano during the course of any move. We only move upright pianos and only from the first (1st) floor of one location to the first (1st) floor of another location.

ITEM 210 - LONG CARRY FEE

If the movers need to carry your goods over a distance greater than 100 feet a long carry fee will be assessed as follows:
\$100 (Over 100 to 125 feet); \$125 (126 to 150 feet);
\$150 (151 to 175 feet); \$200 (176 to 200 feet); with corresponding \$25 increases based on distance carried. Charges will be added to the final cost of the move. There is a separate fee for each location deemed a long carry.

ITEM 220 - ADDITIONAL LABOR

We may provide, at the request of the shipper, additional labor to the job. Each additional laborer will increase the hourly rate by twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars.

ITEM 230 - ADDITIONAL TRUCKS

If your property to be moved is deemed too large to fit on one truck, carrier may use an additional truck. There is a fee of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars for each additional truck.

ITEM 240 - OVERNIGHT CHARGE

In the event that customer needs to store its goods overnight on any of our trucks we will impose a two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollar fee per truck per night. In addition the hourly rate will begin to accrue starting at 9 a.m. on the next business day or the earliest time we are able to continue your move, if later. The hourly rate will continue to accrue until the job is completed. Customer will also be liable for any additional travel time fees, costs of tolls and any other expenses incurred as a result of storing customer goods overnight.

ITEM 250 - TRAVEL CHARGE

Travel time is a fee assessed on any move outside of the Center City area of Philadelphia, PA. Travel time is the time it takes the moving crew to reach your beginning location at the start of the job from our lot in Philadelphia, PA and the time it takes to get back to carrier's lot from the unload destination. Travel time is charged at the same hourly rate as customer's move.

ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 260
PACKING, UNPACKING AND CONTAINER CHARGES

Packing services are offered whether or not a customer chooses to use our moving services. All pack jobs are subject to a two (2) hour minimum. The hourly rate for pack jobs is the same as hourly moving rates shown in Section 3 (Item 300). In addition charges for travel time, fuel surcharges and tolls still apply if applicable.

SECTION 2
ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 270 - FLIGHTS OF STAIRS

Hourly rate will increase based on the number of flights of stairs that the movers must ascend above a third floor, at both the starting and ending addresses and any locations that we deliver to or pickup from along the route. Consider the ground floor and the first floor to be interchangeable terms for the same floor.

Flights of stairs outside of your home or apartment building will be factored into the total number of flights of stairs for you job.

Flights of stairs within your apartment will be factored into the total number of flights of stairs for your job. Flights of stair leading up to attics, roof decks, or crawl spaces in the ceiling will be factored into the total number of flights of stairs for your job.

Any floor above the third floor will increase the hourly rate by ten (\$10.00) dollars per hour.

Every effort to determine the number of flights of stairs involved in your move will be made. However, if the number of flights of stairs is different from our understanding when we submitted our estimate, we reserve the right to adjust the hourly rate according to the number of flights of stairs involved in your move.

SECTION 3
HOURLY RATES

ITEM 300

Applicable on the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS IN USE transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

The transportation charge on any shipment shall be a combination of the applicable traveling charge (Item 250) plus hourly charge at applicable rates named in Columns 2 and 3.

Note 3: Hourly rates (Columns 2 and 3) computed in quarter-hour periods; fractions of one quarter-hour considered one quarter-hour.

Note 4: When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the rates named in Columns 1 and 2 shall apply.

Note 5: Every move is subject to a two (2) hour minimum plus travel charge.
