

Dear Administrative Law Judge Watson:

Per your requests on January 7, 2015 enclosed is a statement from my accountant. It shows that I file my taxes not as a corporation but, as sole proprietor under my long sir name of Dutkiewicz. We have shortened the last name to Duke for convenience purposes since the 1960's. Also attached is my Business Entity filing copy with the state of Pennsylvania back in 1995.

The PUC Formal dispute form rules state that since we are not incorporated that we do not need a lawyer:

8. Legal Representation: If you are filing a Formal Complaint as an individual on your own behalf, you are not required to have a lawyer. You may represent yourself at the hearing.

Note: Corporations, associations, partnerships, limited liability companies and political subdivisions are required to have a lawyer represent them at a hearing and to file any motions, answers, briefs or other legal pleadings.

While I believe it to be sound advice on your part in most cases, I must take into consideration the total costs of this undertaking. Interstate has already cost me and or the client at least \$9,000.00 to this point and paying a few thousand dollars more for counsel when Interstate fails to show up, respond, or attempt to follow the rules set forth by the PUC seems careless on my part. Not to mention, they sold the business and changed the name.

If you still believe it necessary for me to obtain counsel for the March 23, 2015 "Call in Telephone Hearing" at 10:00 AM, please let me know. I will do my best to obtain one. But, I am a small business owner and sometimes small businesses can not afford a lawyer. Which is why I believe the PUC policy of not having to pay for one in cases such as this, can be very helpful in fighting back or even challenging a large unethical and unresponsive company. Thank you for your anticipated consideration.
