Re: Choice Energy LLC d/b/a 4 Choice Energy, A-2012-2337893 Updates to EGS Application Granted July 16, 2013

Dear Ms. Chiavetta:

On behalf of Choice Energy, LLC d/b/a 4 Choice Energy ("Choice"), and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 54.34, we are providing additional materials to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") to update Choice's previously approved license application. The following information updates Section 5 of the Application, pertaining to Compliance.

a. CRIMINAL/CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TERRY MURRAY, individually and on behalf of all others similarly situated, v. CHOICE ENERGY, LLC d/b/a 4 Choice Energy, an Iowa limited liability company, and PREMIERE BUSINESS SOLUTIONS, LLC, an Iowa limited liability company.

United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio, Western Division, Case No. 1:15-cv-00060-TSB (the "Litigation")

b. SUMMARY:

The Litigation, a purported class action, was filed on January 28, 2015. As of this writing, Choice has not filed a responsive answer, but will do so within applicable court rules. The pleading alleges that Choice, as well as Premiere Business Solutions, LLC ("Premiere") has violated the Telephone Consumer Protection Act, codified at 47 U.S.C. § 227 et seq. Choice received formal notification of the Litigation on or about February 23, 2015, from its Ohio

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registered agent. Choice will vigorously contest this case and challenge the request for class

action certification. In addition, while there is a partial overlap in management of Choice and

Premiere, the Company is engaging separate counsel and may seek cross claims against Premiere

if deemed appropriate and necessary. At this time, due to the early stage of the Litigation, the

degree of Choice's liability, if any, cannot be determined. A copy of the complaint is attached.

c. CUSTOMER/REGULATORY/PROSECUTORY ACTIONS:

PUCO Case No. 14-01-AU-RPT – Annual Report Filing for Calendar 2013 (the "Filing")

d. SUMMARY:

The Public Utility Commission of Ohio ("PUCO") assessed a \$1,000 penalty against

Choice for failure to file an annual report for calendar year 2013, and Choice faced the

possibility of revocation of its license to engage in retail sale of electricity if a late filing was not

made by a specific deadline. Choice immediately responded to PUCO's August 20, 2014 letter;

Choice, while licensed, did not serve any customers in Ohio during calendar year 2013 and

therefore did not file an annual report. Choice immediately made a retroactive filing. On August

28, 2014, Choice issued a written request to PUCO that the \$1,000 penalty be waived. PUCO

granted the waiver request on December 10, 2014. Choice has no further liability in this matter.

Choice takes the allegations in the Litigation very seriously and intends to vigorously

defend the lawsuit and the allegations contained in the complaint. Choice will provide updates to

the PUC as needed regarding the status of this litigation.

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
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
